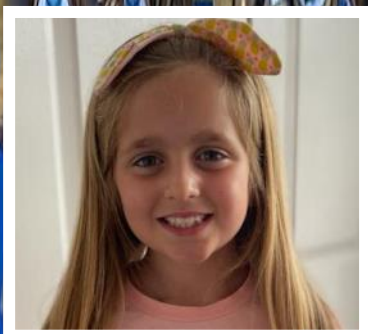


Presentations were made to 2 girls who were on holiday, the day of our presentations they were:
